Section II: Teacher as Lifelong Learner: Reflection on the Burton College of Education Conceptual Framework

1. Professionalism
2. Diversity
3. Collaboration
4. Reflection

*This reflection piece should clearly integrate the Conceptual Framework (CF) principles of professionalism, diversity, collaboration & reflection to **Teacher as Life-long Learner** and include goals for continued learning. It should also include well developed connections regarding the student teaching experience to all parts of CF.*

1. Lesson plans (Technology)
2. *A summary paper of how technology is integrated in your instruction; describe student's integration and use of technology; personal use of technology; school-wide use of technology. Include the pros and cons of technology use.*

Section IV: Management

1. Description of classroom management plan/routines
2. Copy of daily schedule
3. *Reflection: Describe in a few paragraphs what you currently believe will be the classroom management plan and the discipline strategies you will use in your own classroom. Why do you believe these techniques will be effective?*
